

Deputy Spokesperson

Bylaws: Belle II has a single Spokesperson, a 2-year position, with no Deputy. The IB plans to amend the Bylaws in June to establish the position of Deputy Spokesperson. (Note: CMS, Atlas, and LHCb have Deputy Spokespersons)

Purpose

- A Deputy could help the Spokesperson handle administrative tasks that land on his/her desk
- A Deputy could be at KEK when the Spokesperson cannot
- A Deputy can attend ceremonial events and visit countries the Spokesperson cannot make it to
- A Deputy can step in for the Spokesperson if the Spokesperson falls ill, is incapacitated, etc.

The IB is now iterating on the By-laws wording, in consultation with lijima-san (incoming Spokesperson)

EB role:

The Deputy Spokesperson would be nominated by the Spokesperson in consultation with the Chairs of the EB and IB. The motivation here is that if the EB sees a problem with a particular candidate, that can be flagged at this early stage. Alternatively, the EB can bring an especially good candidate for Deputy to the attention of the Spokesperson.
