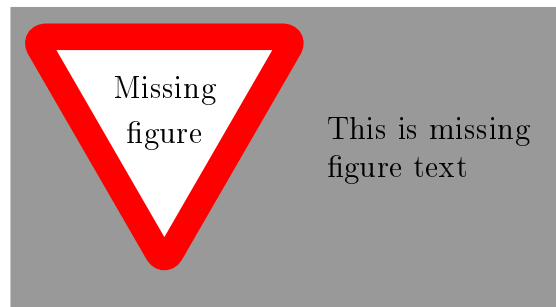


Figure 1: Some caption can already be here
